Dear Public Land Interest:

As you are probably aware, the Bureau of Land Management is in the process of monitoring the rangeland conditions of the public lands, including allotments within the Egan Resource Area. This monitoring includes utilization, condition, climate, and trend studies as well as actual grazing use information from the range users and studies which are specific to non-livestock use such as wildlife and wild horses. This study data collected will be evaluated to determine whether or not allotment objectives are met (see the Egan Rangeland Program Summary). Agreements will then be executed or decisions issued based on the findings of the evaluation. All agreements and decisions in the Egan Resource Area are planned to be issued by the end of 1993. The allotments in which this process will occur this year are the "improve" (I) and "maintain" (M) category allotments which are found on the enclosed list and map.

If you wish to be involved in the monitoring and evaluation process please notify us in writing of your desire. Please specify which allotments you are interested in being involved with and what level of involvement. You may also involve yourself at any future point in the process, for any specific allotment, by notifying us in writing at that time. In addition, if you are interested in reviewing monitoring data collected to date on any specific allotment, please contact this office.


