Dear Mr. Maestri:

We have received your application to change the season of use on your livestock grazing permits within the Rochester and Rawhide Allotments. Attached are copies of the existing BLM grazing permit and your grazing application that reflects the proposed changes. Your application proposes to change the season of use within the Rochester, Rawhide and Star Peak allotments, however the Star Peak allotment doesn't appear on the BLM permit since it is for exchange of use grazing on private lands.

The new grazing regulations require the authorized officer to consult, cooperate, and coordinate (CCC) with affected permittees, the State Agencies responsible for managing resources within the area, and the interested public prior to the modification of grazing permits (43 CFR 4130.3-3). Therefore, a copy of this letter will be sent to anyone who has expressed an interest in the Rochester and Rawhide Allotments. **The interested public is being asked to provide comment by October 6, 1999.**

The terms and conditions are also consistent with the Sonoma-Gerlach Resource Management Plan. The impacts of livestock grazing under these terms and conditions have been analyzed in the Sonoma-Gerlach Resource Management Plan Environmental Impact Statement.

ANY CATTLE OWNED OR CONTROLLED BY YOU FOUND ON THE ROCHESTER, RAWHIDE OR STAR PEAK ALLOTMENTS WITHOUT BLM ISSUED EARTAGS WILL BE DEEMED IN EXCESS OF YOUR AUTHORIZED NUMBERS AND A VIOLATION OF 43 CFR 4140.1(B) (1).

FURNISH YEARLY PROOF OF PAYMENT ON LEASES OFFERED FOR EXCHANGE OF USE.

SALT AND/OR MINERAL BLOCKS SHALL NOT BE PLACED WITHIN ONE QUARTER (1/4) MILE OF SPRINGS, STREAMS, MEADOWS, RIPARIAN HABITATS, OR ASPEN STANDS.

THE PERMITTEE IS REQUIRED TO PERFORM NORMAL MAINTENANCE ON THE RANGE IMPROVEMENTS AS PER THEIR SIGNED COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS/SECTION 4 PERMITS PRIOR TO TURNING OUT IN A PASTURE OR USE AREA SCHEDULED FOR LIVESTOCK USE.

THE PERMITTEE'S CERTIFIED ACTUAL USE REPORT, BY PASTURE/USE AREA, IS DUE 15 DAYS AFTER THE END OF THE AUTHORIZED GRAZING PERIOD.

IF PAYMENT IS NOT RECEIVED WITHIN 15 DAYS OF THE DUE DATE, YOU WILL BE CHARGED A LATE FEE ASSESSMENT OF \$25.00 OR 10% OF THE GRAZING BILL WHICHEVER IS GREATER, NOT TO EXCEED \$250.00. FAILURE TO MAKE PAYMENT WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE DUE DATE MAY RESULT IN TRESPASS ACTION.
