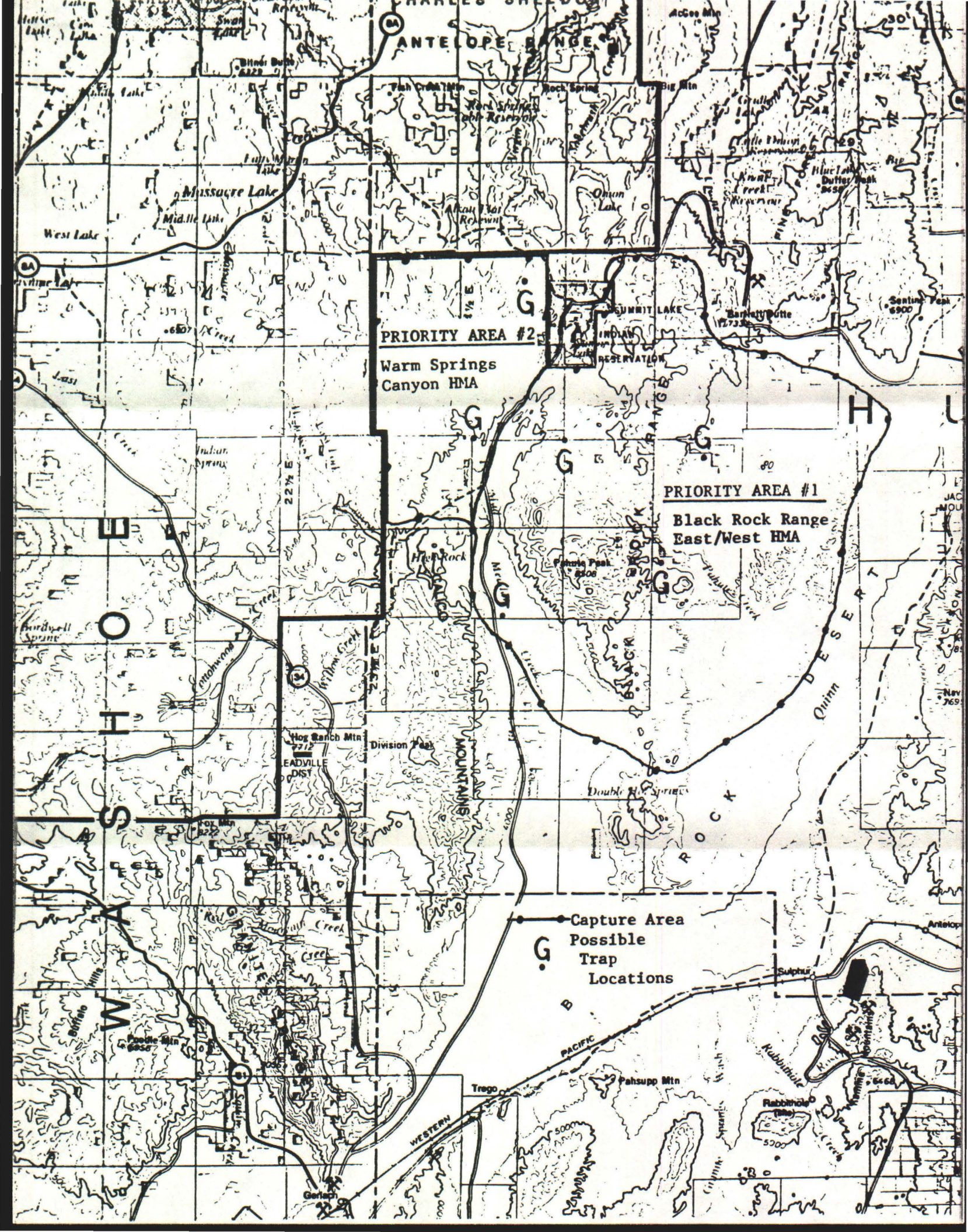

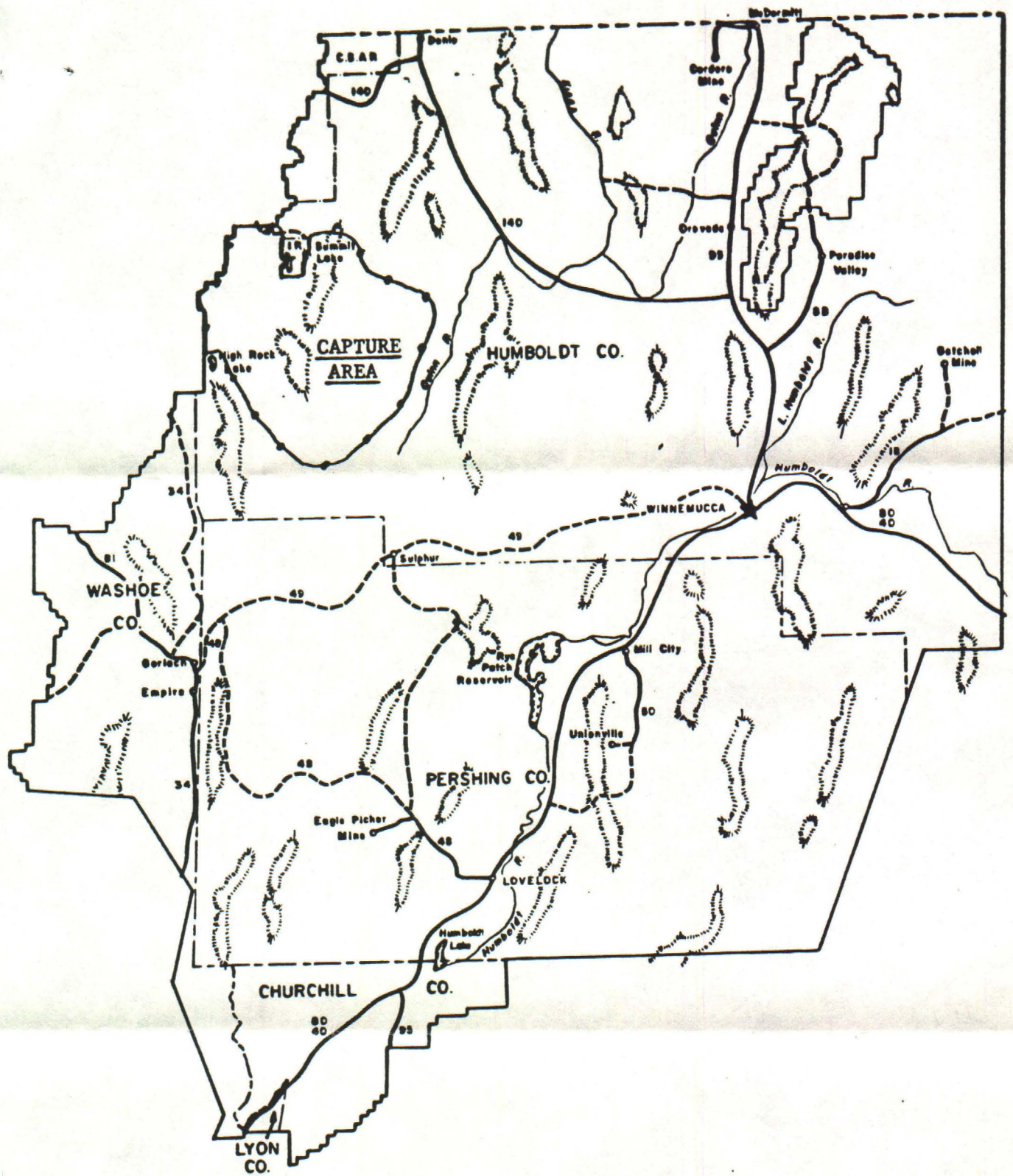
PRIORITY AREA #2
