The proposed gathering will be conducted in the Winnemucca District in the areas shown on the enclosed map and as described below.

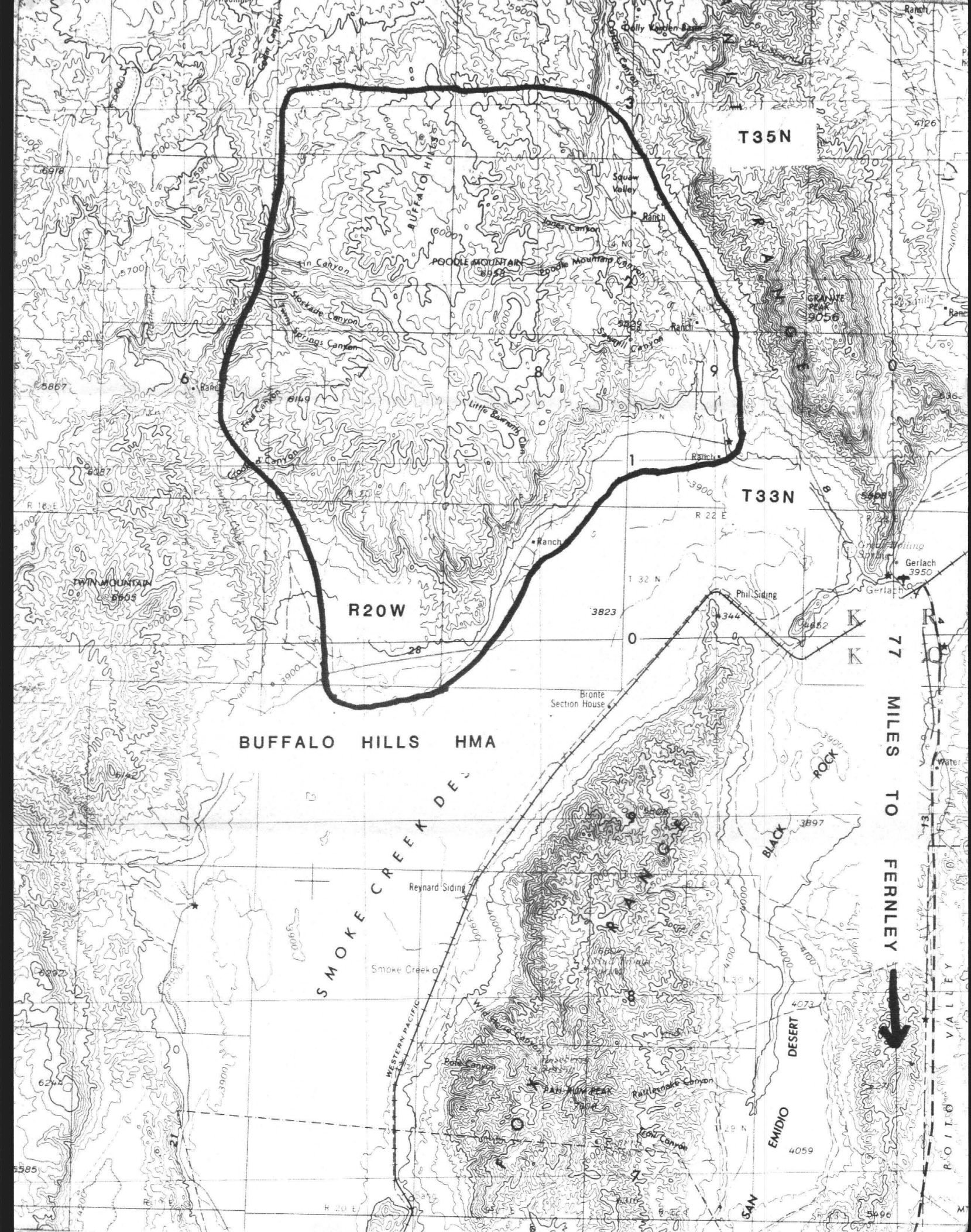
