Gentlemen:

This letter will amend the twenty-eight day notice concerning the Bureau of Land Management's proposal to gather excess wild horses and burros from the Lava Beds/Seven Troughs areas of the Winnemucca District, dated January 27, 1981. This amendment is in response to input from wild horse and burro interest groups following the January 27 notice. The gathering of excess animals pursuant to this amendment will be undertaken no sooner than 28 days from the date of this letter.

The proposed gatherings, as identified in the January 27 notice, were as follows:


