Roger Johnson is currently permitted to use on the Pumpernickel Allotment as follows:

100 C 03/01 to 05/08 = 227 AUM's and 100 C 09/01 to 02/28 = 595 AUM's

Roger Johnson has requested authorization to use the area within the Pump Fire of Summer/Fall 1998. The rehabilitation efforts for the Pump Fire of Summer/Fall 1998 have been deemed a failure on Aug 6, 2001. Mr. Johnson has planned to haul water to several locations within the temporary fence to water his livestock.
