Please find enclosed two maps showing the location of the proposed Mid-Jackson Creek Drift Fence that you and Lynnda Jackson of my staff discussed by phone on June 15, 1995. The proposed fence would be located within the Jackson Mountains Herd Management Area (HMA). Since wild horses have not historically used that portion of the HMA, they would not be affected by construction of the fence.

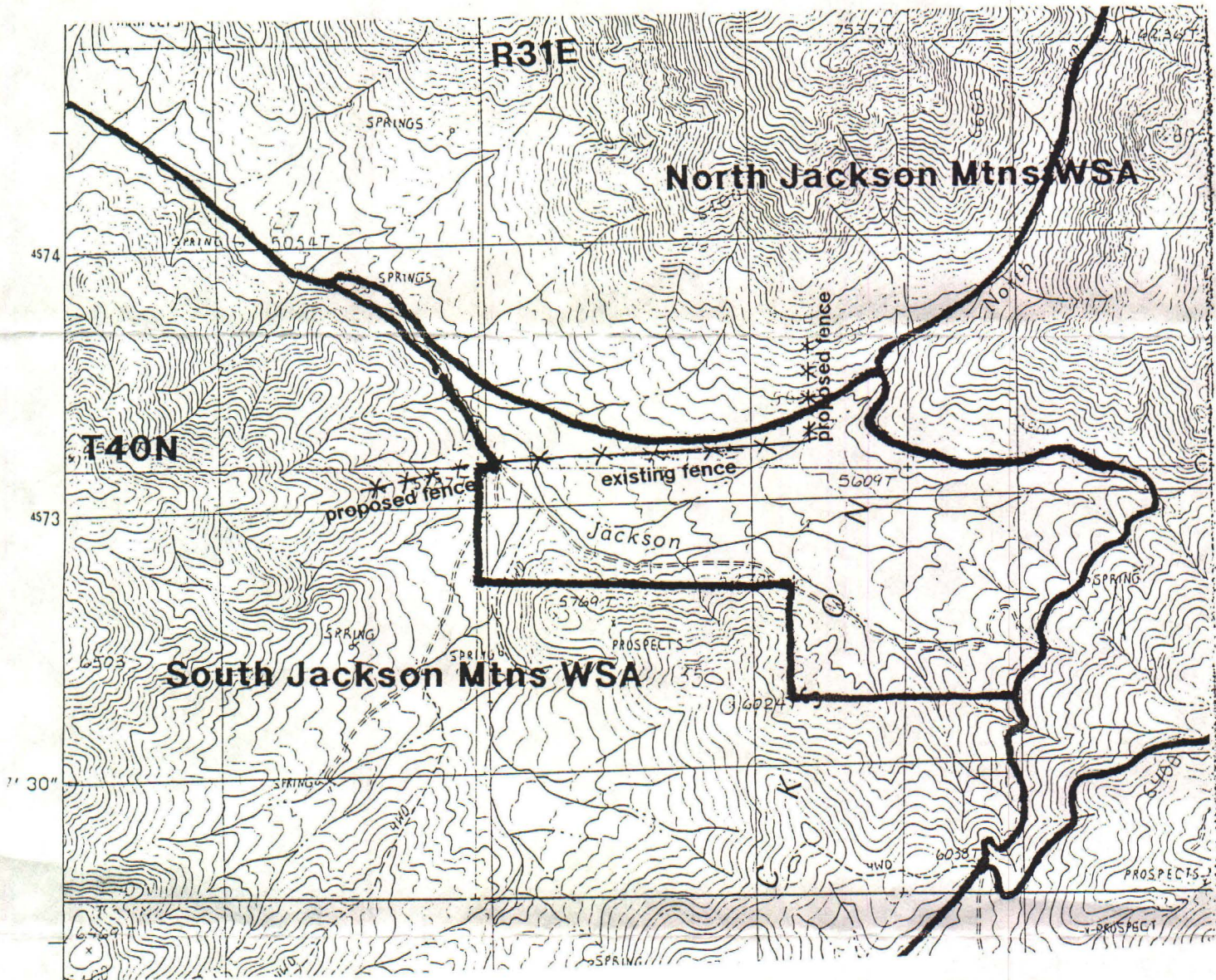
