Dear Mr. Wenker,

Thank you for consulting the Commission for the Preservation of Wild Horse. As you are aware, the Commission has serious concerns for the past and present management of these herds within this 1.5 million acre allotment in Pershing County. The 1995 gather removed over 2300 wild horses and burros. This action should have resulted in profound differences in rangeland monitoring data the past three years.

During our monitoring of the 1995 gathers, we discovered that the District under estimated wild horses by approximately 1000 head. This oversight in the 1994 allotment evaluation's carrying capacity would make a significant difference in the livestock stocking rates and appropriate management levels. This issue has never been resolved.

We viewed the 1994 Final Multiple Use Decision allotment objectives as a possible safety net for the obvious errors in the determination of the appropriate management levels. Unfortunately, the memorandum does not make the determination of mid-season monitoring in regard to the allowable use levels established for wild horses on pastures rested from cattle.

Range improvement projects have not been completed. Monitoring studies were not completed as scheduled. We do not support any future gathers until a proper allotment evaluation is completed. Data may exist that can support or alter the present appropriate
