TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS GRAZING PERMIT ARE IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE STANDARDS AND GUIDELINES FOR THE SIERRA - NORTHWESTERN GREAT BASIN RESOURCE ADVISORY COUNCIL, APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY OF THE INTERIOR ON FEBRUARY 12, 1997.

IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FINAL DECISION, DATED OCTOBER 15, 1999, 139 AUMS WILL BE SUSPENDED AND WILL TAKE EFFECT DURING THE 2000 GRAZING YEAR AS A RESULT OF THE WILD LAND FIRES OF 1999. AS DISCUSSED AT THE SEPTEMBER 13, 1999 MEETING, THE GRAZING SEASON WILL BE SHORTENED AND LIVESTOCK NUMBERS WILL REMAIN CONSTANT. IF RIPARIAN AND UPLAND OBJECTIVES ARE MET, THE GRAZING SEASON COULD BE EXTENDED.

"PURSUANT TO 43 CFR 10.4(G), THE HOLDER OF THIS AUTHORIZATION MUST NOTIFY THE AUTHORIZED OFFICER, BY TELEPHONE, WITH WRITTEN CONFIRMATION, IMMEDIATELY UPON DISCOVERY OF HUMAN REMAINS, FUNERARY OBJECTS, SACRED OBJECTS, OR OBJECTS OF CULTURAL PATRIMONY (AS DEFINED AT 43 CFR 10.2). THE PERMITTEE IS REQUIRED TO PERFORM NORMAL MAINTENANCE ON THE RANGE IMPROVEMENTS AS PER THEIR SIGNED COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS/SECTION 4 PERMITS PRIOR TO TURNING OUT IN A PASTURE OR USE AREA SCHEDULED FOR LIVESTOCK USE.

SALT AND/OR MINERAL BLOCKS SHALL NOT BE PLACED WITHIN ONE QUARTER (1/4) MILE OF SPRINGS, STREAMS, MEADOWS, RIPARIAN HABITATS, OR ASPEN STANDS. ONLY CATTLE BEARING PURPLE BLM ISSUED EAR TAGS WILL BE ALLOWED TO GRAZE ON PUBLIC LAND.

NO GRAZING USE WILL BE MADE IN THE JOHN BASIN SPRING, SPRING CREEK SPRING, OR THE SIARD SPRING WILDLIFE ENCLOSURES.

YOUR BASE PROPERTY LEASE AND EXCHANGE OF USE AGREEMENT EXPIRE ON MARCH 28, 2004.
