Dear Mr. Conard:

The undersigned, Alvin Miller and Mrs. George Miller, lease from Nevada First Corporation all of the privately owned range land of the Nevada First Corporation, situate in the Bloody-Run-Osgood Unit of Humboldt County, Nevada. The fee lands so leased represent approximately fifty per cent (50%) of the entire area of the Bloody-Run Allotment.

There are in excess of five hundred (500) horses ranging on this area to the detriment of the range, as a whole, and, particularly, harmful to the undersigned, whose cattle range in said allotment. We are certain that you are also familiar with the harm done by these horses to springs, water holes and troughs.

The undersigned respectfully request that immediate consideration be given to remove these horses from the Allotment at the cost and expense of the Bureau of Land Management. We ask, particularly, that this be done during 1977, as the problem is becoming more critical month by month.
