Carrying Capacity

Computations of the appeal file are for potential stocking rates. Carrying capacity estimates exceeded past stocking rates for livestock and BLM choose not to increase active preference. Therefore, the FMUD kept active preference and reduced wild horses according to the computations for carrying capacity.

Errors in computations.

- \* Weight averaging use pattern mapping data discounted the heavy and severe use on riparian habitat.
- \* Use of 60% utilization as the desired utilization does not have rational or supportive objectives of the allotment evaluation. 60% overall utilization were to be measured in February. Data presented for Buffalo Hills Pasture were collected on August 1, 1988 and not February.
- \* Actual use data for wild horses is based upon when monitoring data were collected against the start of the growing season on March 1. Therefore, the number of horses are multiplied by the days and divided by days/month. The AUMs are not for the whole year.

Manager's rationale

Carrying capacities are not strictly dependent on computations. Terms and conditions of licenses provide BLM authority to remove cattle when utilization levels are approached or achieved. BLM issued a 10 year term licensed based upon this FMUD.

Reductions in livestock will not meet riparian objectives, however wild horse reductions will. The carrying capacity applies only to horses and not livestock. Fencing will protect riparian areas and projects are pending funding. There is no interim measures.
