Dear Interested Public:

On April 26, 2000, an application was submitted to transfer grazing privileges on the North Butte Valley Allotment from William and Elizabeth Dickinson to Dave and Deanna McCall. The full permitted use of 1,645 AUMs would be transferred (see the enclosed map for the allotment location). Based on the application, we propose to offer a term grazing permit. The term of this permit will be from April 26, 2000 to April 25, 2010.

The new grazing regulations require the authorized officer to consult, cooperate, and coordinate (CCC) with affected permittees, the State agencies responsible for managing resources within the area, and the interested public prior to the issuance of grazing permits (43 CFR 4130.2(b)). Therefore, a copy of this letter and a copy of the acceptance form will be sent to anyone who has expressed an interest in the North Butte Valley Allotment. The interested public is being asked to provide comment by June 2, 2000. You will be notified of any changes to terms and conditions that may be warranted as a result of comments received.

This allotment is within the Maverick/Medicine Wild Horse Herd Management Area.

If we propose to change the terms and conditions following the comment period, we will keep you and the other interested parties informed. Following the comment period, we will also decide if a proposed decision to offer you a term grazing permit will be needed. If a proposed decision is necessary, it will be sent to the interested public and will include a 15-day period for protest and a 30-day period for appeal after the decision has become final.

The terms and conditions outlined are consistent with the Wells Resource Management Plan and have been analyzed in the Wells Resource Management Plan Environmental Impact Statement.
