Dear Mr. Robison:

An evaluation of the multiple use objectives identified for the Badlands and Goshute Mountain Allotments was completed and a Final Multiple Use Decision was issued on June 18, 1998. No appeals were received. This multiple use decision identified the management actions necessary to meet these multiple use objectives.

The enclosed grazing permit is a statement of your permitted use on the public lands administered by the BLM, and includes the terms and conditions described in the Final Multiple Use Decision for the Badlands and Goshute Mountain Allotments. The term of your grazing permit will be from March 1, 1996 to February 28, 2006.

Please review the terms and conditions printed on both sides of the grazing permit. If you accept the terms, conditions, and information stated herein, please sign and return both copies to this office. An approved copy will be returned to you for your files.

SUSPENDED NONUSE ASSOCIATED WITH THE ANTELOPE VALLEY ALLOTMENT IS 130 AUMS.

AS OUTLINED IN THE ANTELOPE VALLEY FINAL MULTIPLE USE DECISION 2,555 AUMS ARE PLACED INTO NONUSE FOR CONSERVATION AND PROTECTION OF THE FEDERAL RANGE.

AUTHORIZED GRAZING WILL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE AREA MANAGER'S FINAL MULTIPLE USE DECISION FOR THE ANTELOPE VALLEY ALLOTMENT DATED DECEMBER 22, 1994.

AUTHORIZED GRAZING WILL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FINAL MULTIPLE USE DECISION FOR THE BADLANDS AND GOSHUTE MOUNTAIN ALLOTMENTS DATED JUNE 18, 1998.

AN ACTUAL USE REPORT, BY PASTURE, MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THIS OFFICE ANNUALLY WITHIN 15 DAYS OF COMPLETION OF AUTHORIZED USE.

PURSUANT 43 CFR 10.4(G) THE HOLDER OF THIS AUTHORIZATION MUST NOTIFY THE AUTHORIZED OFFICER, BY TELEPHONE, WITH WRITTEN CONFIRMATION, IMMEDIATELY UPON THE DISCOVERY OF HUMAN REMAINS, FUNERARY ITEMS, SACRED OBJECTS, OR OBJECTS OF CULTURAL PATRIMONY. FURTHER, PURSUANT

TO 43 CFR 10.4(C) AND (D), YOU MUST STOP ACTIVITIES IN THE IMMEDIATE VICINITY OF THE DISCOVERY AND PROTECT IT FROM YOUR ACTIVITIES FOR 30 DAYS OR UNTIL NOTIFIED TO PROCEED BY THE AUTHORIZED OFFICER.

SUPPLEMENTAL FEEDING IS LIMITED TO SALT, MINERAL AND/OR PROTEIN SUPPLEMENTS IN BLOCK, GRANULAR OR LIQUID FORM. SUCH SUPPLEMENTS MUST BE PLACED AT LEAST 1/4 MILE FROM LIVE WATERS (SPRINGS, STREAMS, AND TROUGHS), WET OR DRY MEADOWS, AND ASPEN STANDS.

ALL RIPARIAN ENCLOSURES, INCLUDING SPRING DEVELOPMENT ENCLOSURES, ARE CLOSED TO LIVESTOCK USE UNLESS SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZED IN WRITING BY THE AREA MANAGER.

PAYMENT OF GRAZING FEES IS DUE ON OR BEFORE THE DUE DATE SPECIFIED ON THE GRAZING BILL. FAILURE TO PAY THE GRAZING BILL WITHIN 15 DAYS OF THE DUE DATE SPECIFIED ON THE BILL SHALL RESULT IN A LATE FEE ASSESSMENT OF \$25.00 OR 10 PERCENT OF THE GRAZING BILL, WHICHEVER IS GREATER, BUT NOT TO EXCEED \$250.00.
