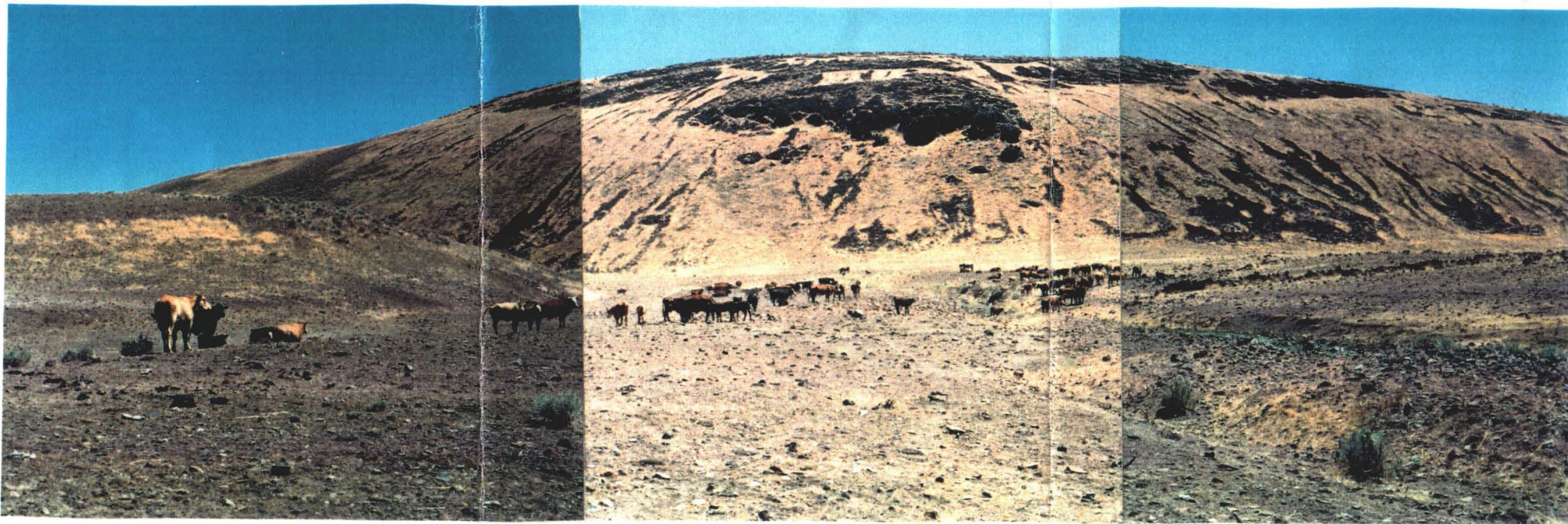

TWIN PEAKS ALLOTMENT MONITORING 1994
STREAMBANK RIPARIAN HABITAT
SUBUNIT CRITICAL DEER WINTER RANGE

Decision Record (March 6, 1992) Allotment Objective
"Utilization of Key Streambank Riparian Species Shall Not
Exceed 40% On Buffalo, Parsnip and Smoke Creek"



Note: Approximately 200 to 250 head of livestock comprised of cows and calves were concentrated on private and public portions of the Chimney Tributary of Smoke Creek. South slopes are bare within a mile radius of water. There were no wild horses observed and sign suggests very little use by horses.
