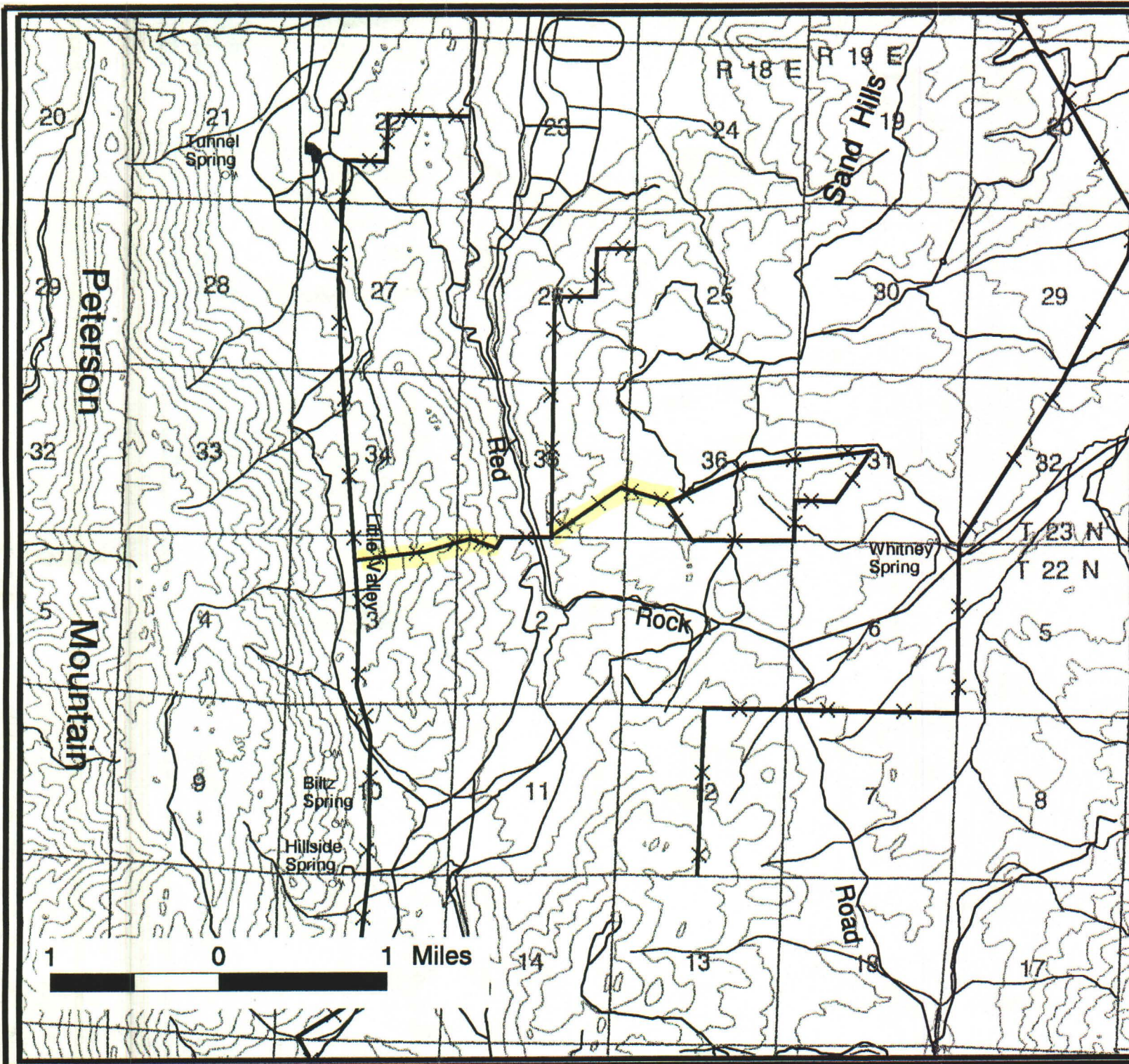
1. Map of proposed drift fences.
