Dear Interested Public:

On April 20, 1996, Henry C. Vogler of DBA Need More Sheep Co. delivered to this office a base property lease from Bertrand Paris and Sons to DBA Need More Sheep Co. for the West Cherry Creek Allotment for a period of three years. DBA Need More Sheep Co. meets all of the qualifications for a grazing permittee outlined in 43 CFR 4110.1, and this permit renewal complies with the regulations governing permit renewals and issuance of permits outlined in 43 CFR 4110.2-1, 4110.2-2. This permit was approved on June 6, 1996, and will be renewed upon renewal of the base property lease, not to exceed ten years.

A Multiple Use Decision for the West Cherry Creek Allotment was completed in 1994. The terms and conditions outlined in the term permit are consistent with the West Cherry Creek Final Multiple Use Decision for the West Cherry Creek Allotment. This allotment is within the ~~Maverick/Medicine~~ Wild Horse Herd Management Area.

The terms and conditions of the renewal permit are also consistent with the Wells Resource Management Plan. The impacts of livestock grazing under these terms and conditions have been analyzed in the Wells Resource Management Plan Environmental Impact Statement.
