As for the water, to the
Valley on the east side without
Fallis pipe line there probably

main source & it needs
redeveloped.

Silver Bowl Valley where
O + M is just had water
at O + M if tunnel is dry
because of Rose spring &
lower Rose were not running
last summer - needed new
pipes & etc. They said Broom
Creek was almost dry but
we couldn't go up there.

The spring west of O + M
(south of the airport on Lactus
Range) is called Lactus - be
sure & check it.

And on the west side there
is hardly any water anymore.
Used to be water at Wild
Horse Spring & Stonewall - check
them.
