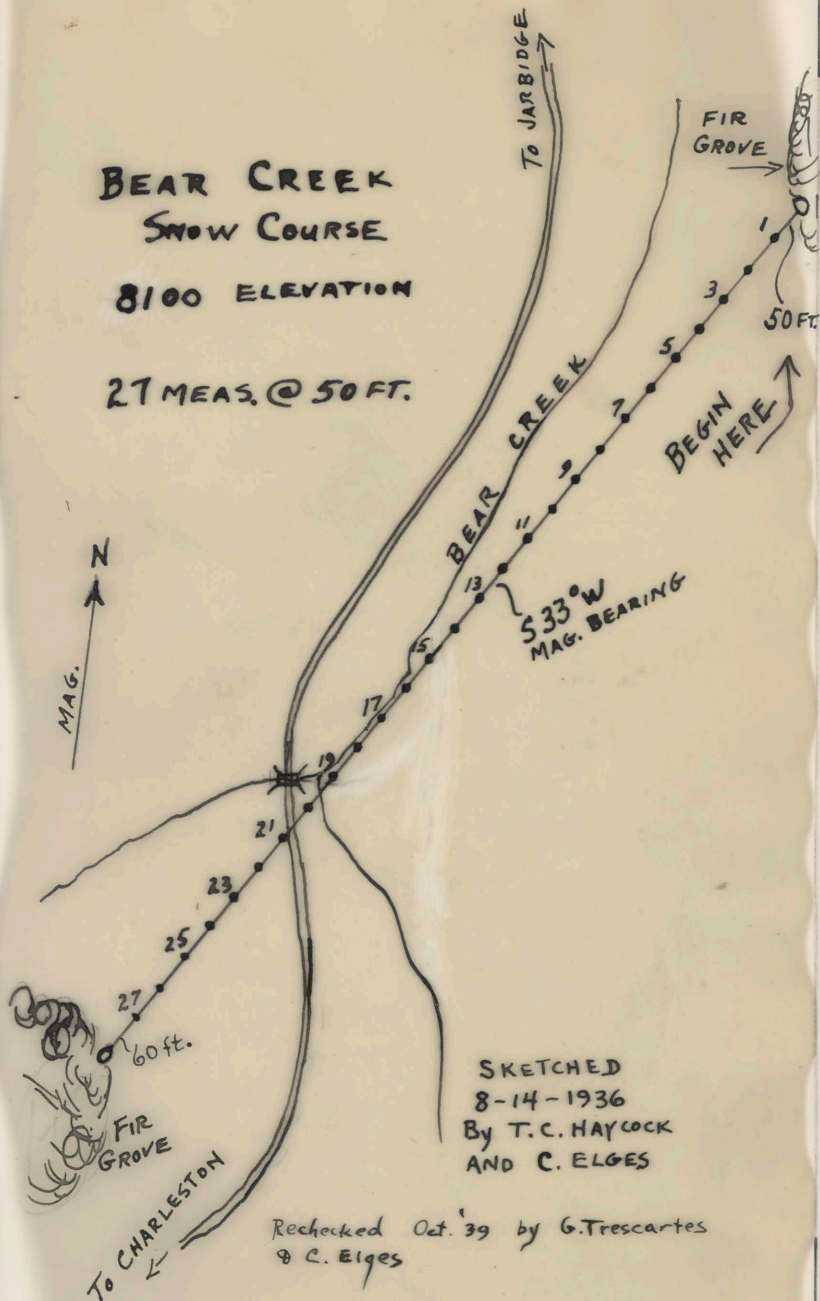

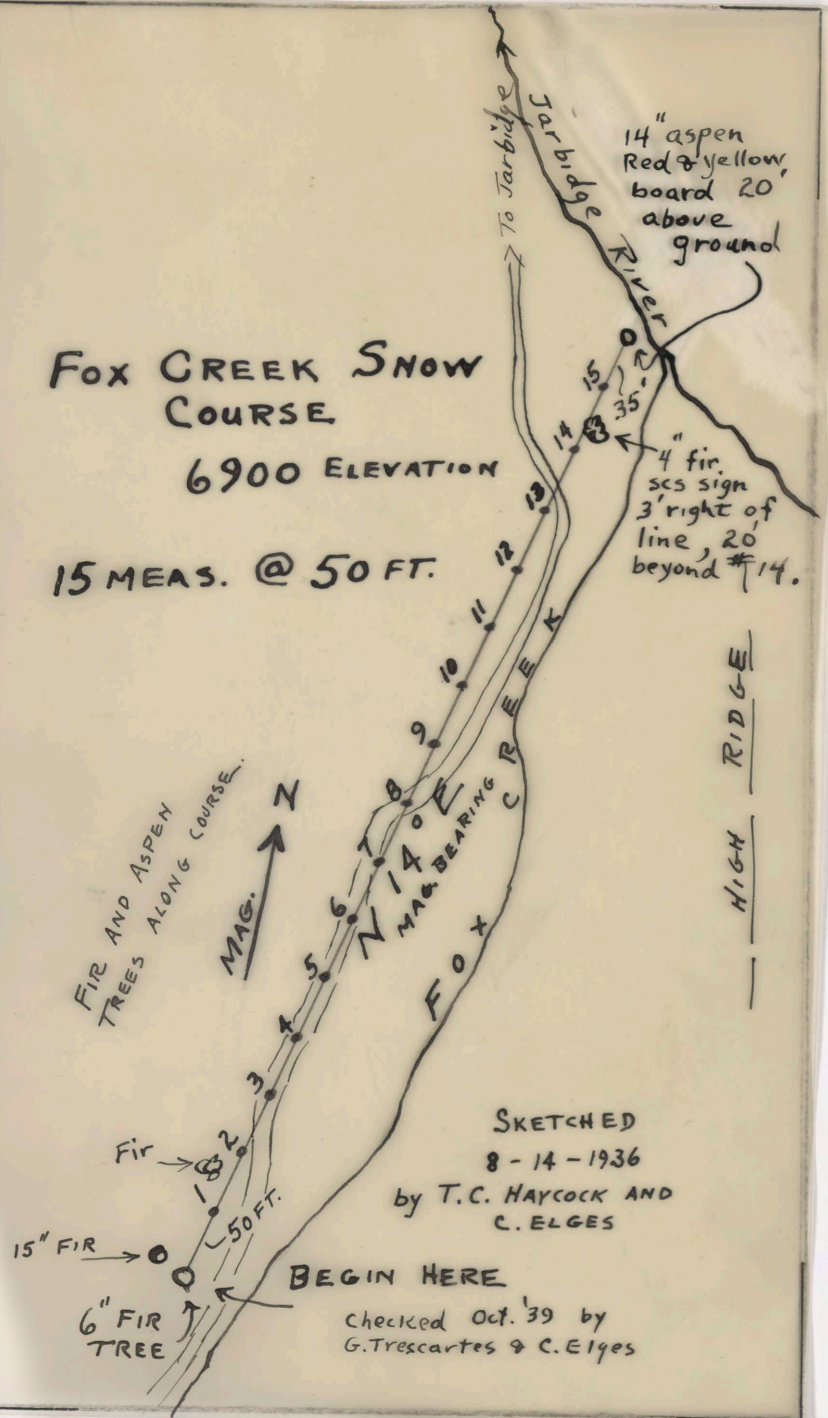

6900 ELEVATION

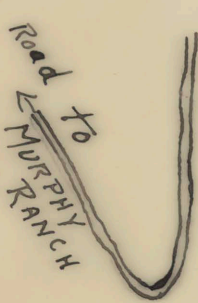

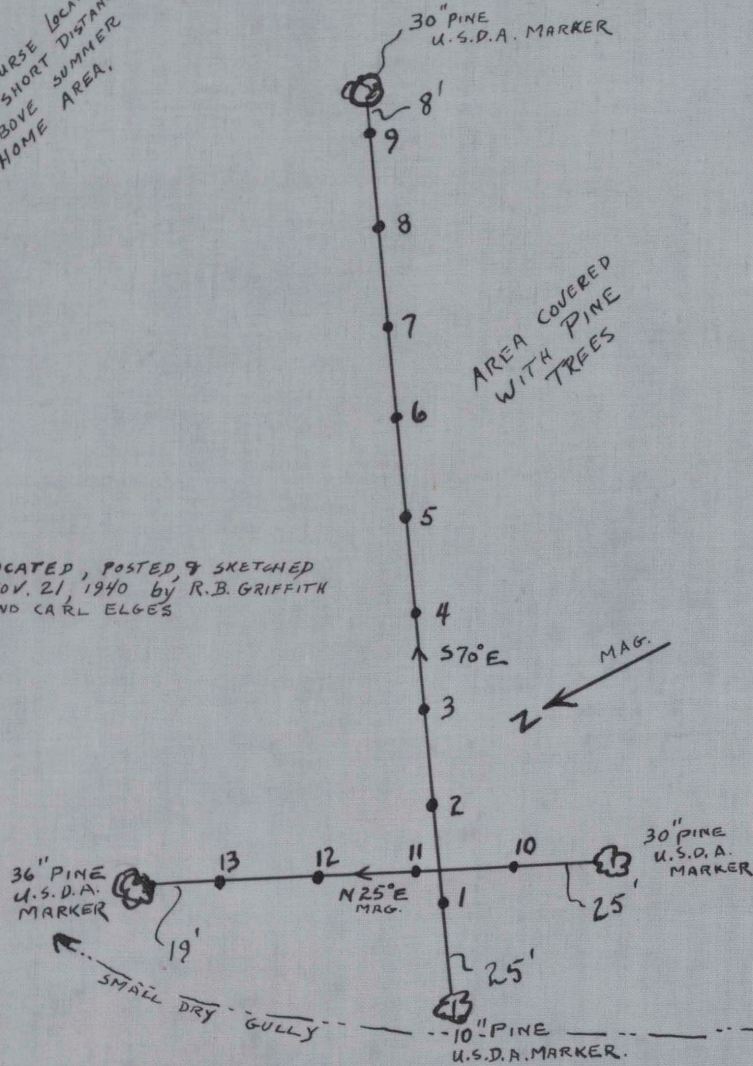

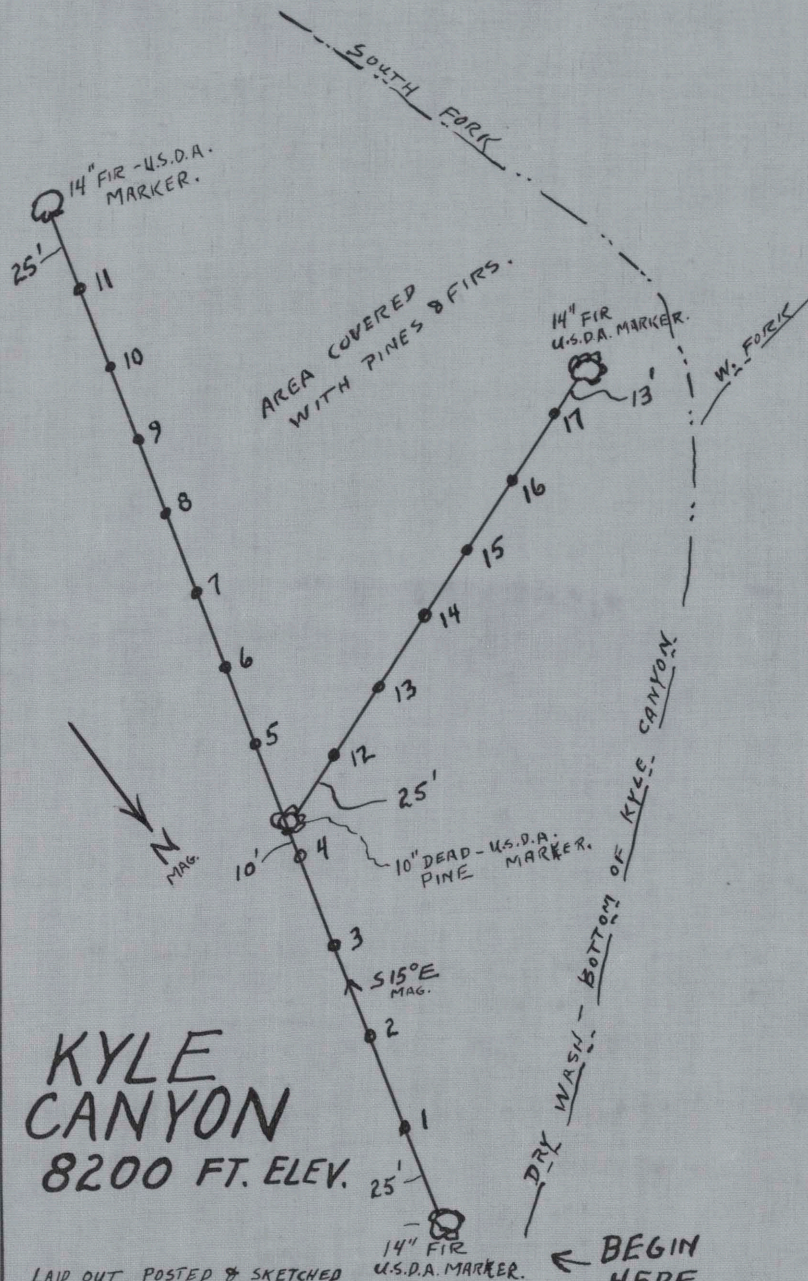
COURSE LOCATED

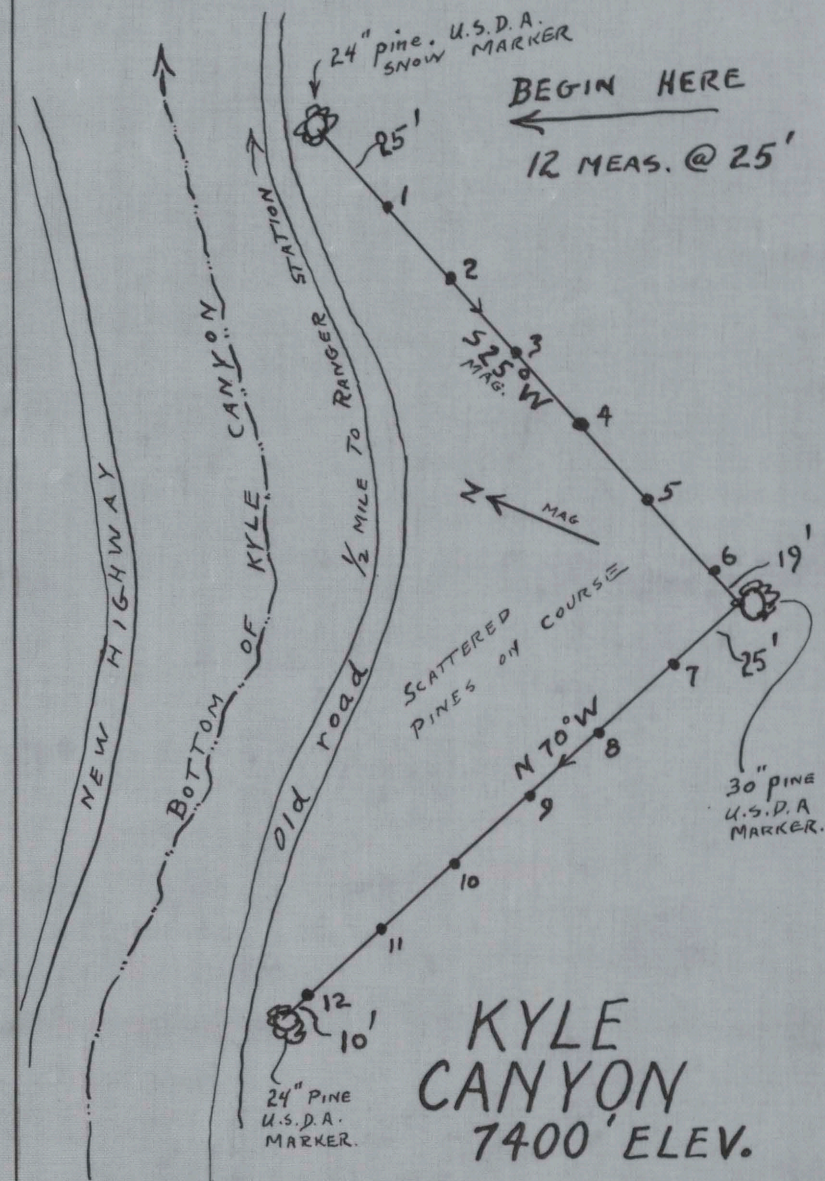
