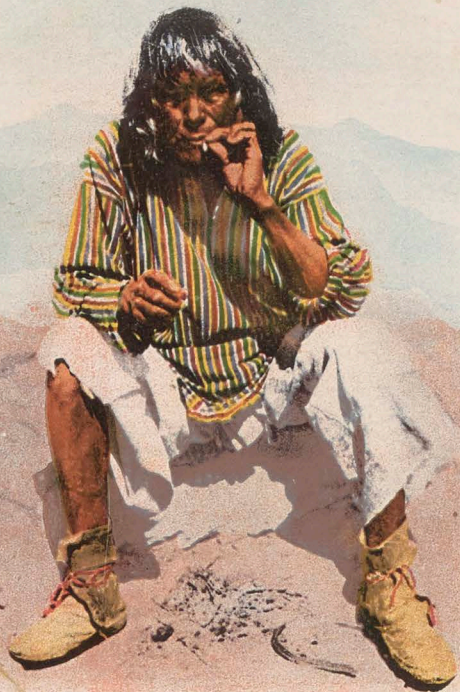
Gov. Sparks:

Dear Sir:--The enclosed clipping suggests to me an inquiry I was going to make when you were last in Denver, but you had left when I called. Are you the Wyoming cattleman of about a quarter of a century ago for whom "Spark's Butte" on the North Platte is named? It is six mile down the river from Douglas, which was started 21 years ago at the eastern line of the old Ft. Fetterman reservation. I have an irrigated ranche at its foot, which I settled in 1886. This inquiry is prompted solely by historic interest. I was editor of the Denver News previous to that time and have been asked to prepare an historical sketch.
