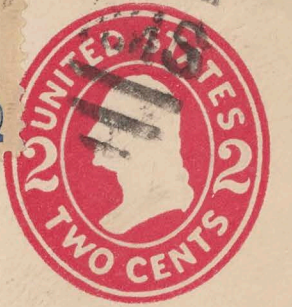

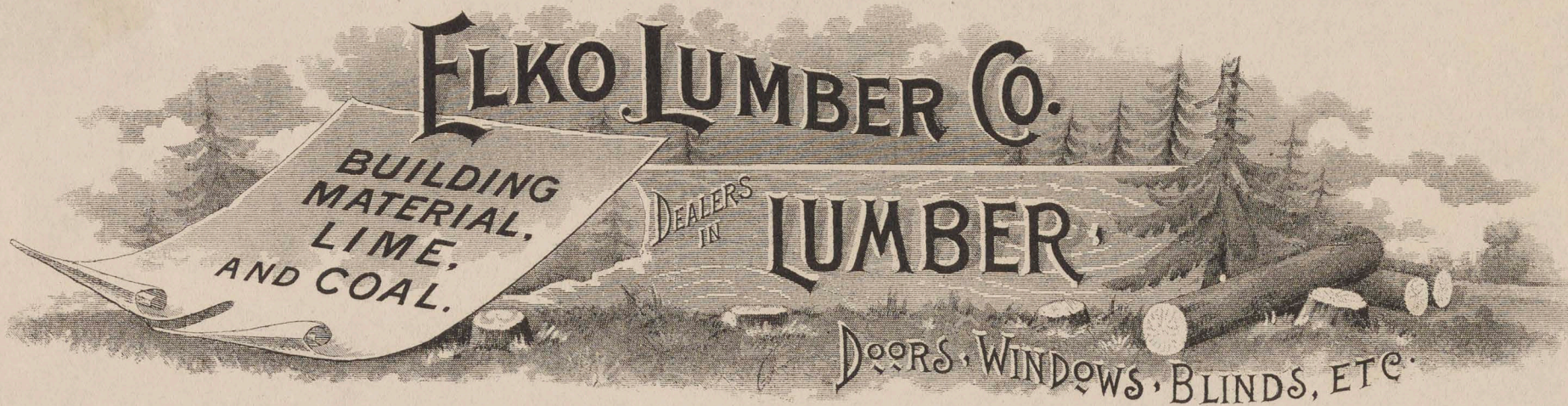

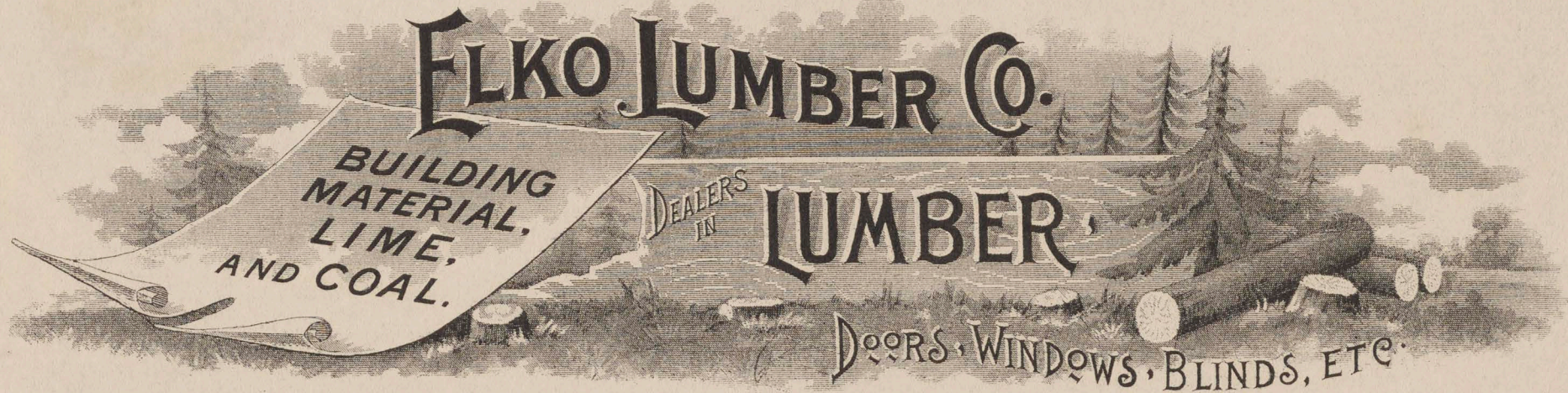
Our extension on the permit says that we must start the work before the first of July which we did and the law says we must make an affidavit within thirty days from the time set by the State Engineer for the commencement of work. So you see we should have until the last of this month to file this in.

I wish you would telephone Emmet to call you up when he comes to Reno so you can talk with him and find out for sure that we are all right on our application.

Scrugham will be here soon and we will be able to determine just where we will take the water out of the creek and in the mean time we will keep right on with the old application.

Emmet wrote me that if we wished to change our plans we must make out another application to do so. As soon as we are sure I will send in the application. Another thing I wish you would find out is if the other people would have any chance to get ahead of us as the applications are filed for the power.

All we wish to do is to take the water out of the stream a little lower down but put it back in the same place as we first intended.
