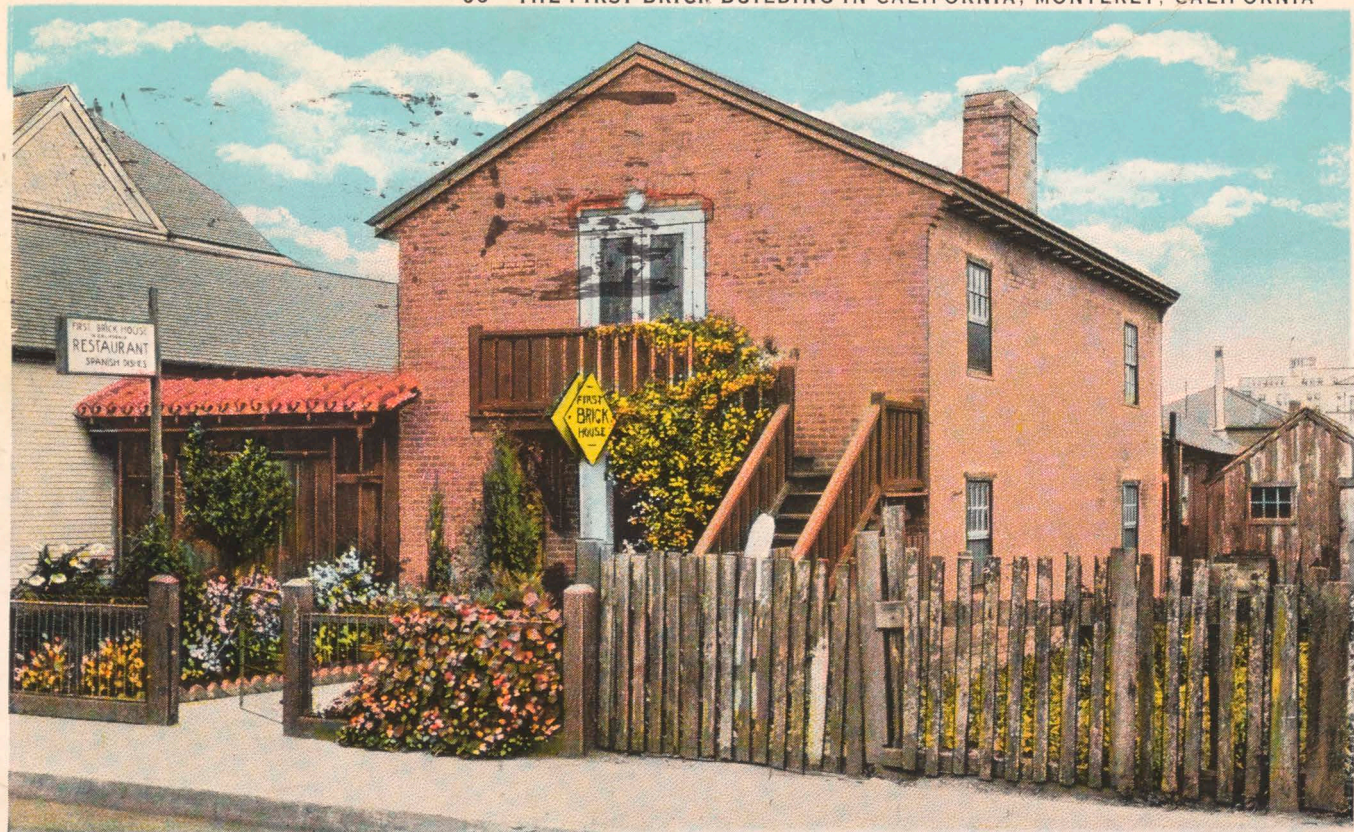


60 THE FIRST BRICK BUILDING IN CALIFORNIA, MONTEREY, CALIFORNIA

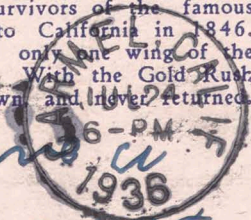


FIRST BRICK HOUSE.
