The Industrial Arts courses given in high school aid the National Defense Program, because they teach boys and young men how to do Mechanical Drawings and teach them to become Engineers, Draftsmen, and other like trades.⁷⁶

They also aid the National Defense by giving courses in Foundry, Machine Shop, Electric shop, and Auto shop, all of which could be useful in National Defense.⁶³

Foundry is useful in that it teaches how to pour metal so that it won't crack, teaches at what degree of heat the different kinds of metal will melt, what kinds of metal are best for certain articles, and other things of importance.¹⁰⁶

We have been manufacturing war goods for Britain and ourselves. Unless we get more skilled mechanics, machinists, and other skilled laborers that will not strike every time there is a national emergency, America will no longer be a land of the free.¹⁴⁹ The high schools are helping to correct
