second-part: Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first-
part, for and in consideration of the sum of five hun-
dred dollars in hand paid by the said party of the
second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
both granted, bargained, sold, remise, released, ali-
-ened, and confirmed, ~~and confirmed~~ and by these
presentes doth grant, bargain, sell, remise, release alien-
and confirm, unto the said party of the second part and
to his heirs and assigns, forever All that certain piece or
pieces, parcel or parcels, of land situate, lying and being
situated in the Town of Princetown Iowa County Wis-
-consin Territory as known and marked on plat of said
Town Lot Ten in Block Thirty two, also Lot Four in
Block sixty six, also Lot three in Block Seventy—
Together with all and singular, the tenements and
appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any wise appertain-
-ing; and the ^{reversions} ~~reversions~~ remainder and remainances,
rents, issues and profits thereof; and all the estate,
right, title, interest, claim or demand whatsoever, of
the said parties of the first-part, within in law or
equity, of, in and to the above bargained premises, with
the tenements and appurtenances, To Have and
To Hold, the said premises as above described
with the ~~above~~ appurtenances, unto the said party of
the second part, and his heirs and assigns forever
And the said Uriah B. Smith John Cross and
Lucy his wife of the first-part, for themselves the

kins, executor, and administrators, doth covenant, grant, bargain, and agree, to and with the said party of the second part, and his heirs, and assigns that at the time of the enrolling and delivery of these presents, they are well seized of the premises above conveyed, as of a good, sure, perfect, absolute and inalienable estate of inheritance in the said premises in fee simple, and hath good right, full power, and lawful authority, to grant, bargain, sell and convey the same in manner and form as aforesaid, and that the same are free and clear of all incumbrances of what kind and nature soever; and that the above bargained premises, in ^{the} quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, against all and every person or persons, lawfully claiming or to claim the whole or any part thereof, well forewarned, warranted and defended.
