money of the United States, to *him* in hand paid, at or before the enscaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, had granted, bargained, and sold, aliened, released, enfeoffed, conveyed, and confirmed; and by these presents *do* grant, bargain, and sell, alien, release, enfeoff, convey, and confirm unto the said *David F. Knight*

and to *his* heirs and assigns, *two* certain tract/s or parcel/s of **LAND**, with all the appurtenances, lying and being in the county of *Vermilion*

and State of Illinois. *To-wit:* *Lot No. 17 in the East half of the northwest quarter of Section No. 8, in Township 19, N. of Range 11 W., beginning 31 poles south of the southwest*

corner in the west boundary line of said half quarter, thence north 100 poles to a Stake, thence east 16 poles to a Stake, thence south 100 poles to a Stake, thence west 16 poles to the place of beginning, containing 10 Acres,

also Lot No. 22 in the west half of the northwest quarter of Section No. 9, Township 19 north Range 11 W., beginning 31 poles north of the southwest corner of said lot,

thence north 50 poles to a Stake, and black walnut 3 inches in diameter bearing north 25 west 19 links, thence east 80 poles to a Stake and white oak 15 inches diameter bearing N. 12 links, thence south 50 poles to a Stake, thence west 80 poles to the place of beginning.
