

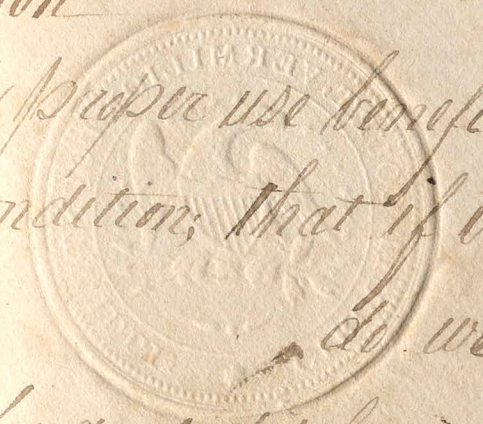

This Indenture made this twenty second day of May in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty five between David
F. Knight of the county of Vermilion
and State of Illinois of the one part and Thomas S. Elston
of the ~~same~~ ^{of Putnam} county, and State ^{aforesaid} of the other part Witness
eth: that the said David F. Knight for and
in consideration of the sum of Two hundred Dollars
current money of the United States to him in hand paid by the
said Thomas S. Elston at and before the
sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby ac-
knowledge hath given, granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed and
confirmed and by these presents do give, grant, bargain, sell, alien, convey
confirm, release and convey unto the said Thomas S. Elston
and to his heirs and assigns forever, all that lot or
parcel of land lying and being situate in the Town of Danville, County of
Vermilion, and State of Illinois, and known on the plat of said Town
by Lot N^o Three in Block two North and Range One East of the public
Square in said Town
Together with all houses, out houses, and other improvements there situate
and being with all and singular the hereditaments, rights, titles and ad-
vantages to the same legally belonging: to have and to hold the said
lot or parcel of land with all and singular the premises to the same
belonging or appertaining from the said David F. Knight
to the said Thomas S. Elston
and his heirs and assigns to his, and their only proper use benefit and
behalf forever. Provided however upon this condition, that if the
above named David F. Knight or his heirs, assigns, or assigns well
and truly without defealcation content pay satisfy and discharge one
promissory note of hand given by the said David F. Knight



on the twenty second day of
May A.D. 1835 to the said Thomas S. Edston
that is to say one note for the sum of two hundred Dollars
payable two years after date, and dated May 22^d 1835

It being understood and agreed by and between the parties aforesaid that
if the said David S. Knight shall well and truly
by discharge said note agreeably to the true intent and meaning of
the same that then this Indenture and every part thereof is to be
null and void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue
