



This Indenture, made this *Sixteenth* day of *October* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty *two* between *Jesse Williams*

of the County of *Pike*, and State of *Ohio* of the one part, and *David F. Knight* of the County of *Vermilion* and State of *Illinois* of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said *Jesse Williams* for and in consideration of the sum of *Fifteen Dollars* current money of the United States, to *him* in hand paid, at and before the ensembling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged; *hath* granted, bargained, and sold, aliened, released, enfeoffed, conveyed, and confirmed: and by these presents do grant, bargain, and sell, alien, release, enfeoff, convey, and confirm, unto the said *David F. Knight and to his heirs and assigns, a* certain tract or parcel of LAND, with all the appurtenances, lying and being in the County of *Vermilion* and State of *Illinois* and known on the plat of the town of *Danville Illinois* by Lot No. *Eight* in Block *Three* North and Range *one* East of the Public Square of *Dan* town, containing *one fourth* part of an acre, be the same more or less


And all the estate, right, title, claim, interest, and fee, of *him* the said *Jesse Williams* of, in and to the same. **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the said tract or parcel of land with all the appurtenances, unto the said *David F. Knight* and to *his* heirs and assigns, to his and their only proper use and behoof, forever. And the said *Jesse Williams* doth covenant and agree with the said *David F. Knight* and with *his* heirs and assigns, that *he* will, and *his* heirs, executors, and administrators, shall **Warrant and Forever Defend** the said tract or parcel of land, with all the appurtenances, unto the said *David F. Knight* and to *his* heirs and assigns, against all and every person or persons whatsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
