Dear Dr. Church,-

I can give you only a rough approximation of the ac-
regges in the Carson Valley and the Truckee Meadows. The Car-
son Valley now comprises about 27,000 acres of irrigated land,
not including 4,898 acres in Lyon County (Dayton). I think
we are safe in assuming that about 1,000 acres have been put in
since 1913 in the Carson Valley.

According to the best figures I can obtain, the Truckee
Meadows now comprise about 14,000 acres of "irrigated and sw_amp
land".

The above figures are approximate, but they may be of
some service to you.
