Galena Creek -

10 a. m. (Upper meadow)

2 sticks set. 2 cuts on each for
max. and min. wave crests in pool.

High water mark on tall stick $9\frac{1}{2}$ in.

[Stream has recently been $1\frac{1}{2}$ -2 in. higher
to judge from surface of rocks still wet.

See pencil mark on rock  set
of sticks. Monday morning: This evidence
not at all conclusive.]

4 p. m. -

Water fallen $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$ in. below both high
and low ^{wave} crest marks. i. e.
high & low crests ^{are} both $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$ lower
than formerly. (?)

Little horizontal flag projecting from
road is just awash at high crest
