

Monday -

White's C. - 9:30 am

Submerged Plug  under bush  
still  $\frac{1}{4}$  in. above wave crests.

New Plug 1 ft. west of other plug  
driven to present water level.

West Stake -

Standard level  $\frac{1}{2}$  in. below notch.

yet high wave crests often rise  
to notch.

Large Rock

Small stone at n.w. corner now  
projects  $\frac{1}{4}$  in.

Quack and Rock by Center Stake -

Submerged Stone now  $\frac{1}{2}$  in. above water.

Stone supporting duck also 1 in. above  
present level. Therefore water fallen  
 $\frac{3}{4}$  or more inches since yesterday.

Rivulet at Center Stake & other two 20 in.  
wide.

Ground in bed of rivulet still moist,  
between extreme stakes, tho' still now  
apparently drying near the edges somewhat.

Temperature of Water (Beneath bush)  $36^{\circ}+$  F.

B. Temp of Galena ditch water at junction  
with James Creek (just before it enters)  $40^{\circ}$  F.

This after passing in open ditch <sup>(water</sup> 11 in. deep.)  
thro' timber & manganite land for mile.  
Too cold for hay.
