Dear Mrs. Ward:

Answering your letter of April 10, I hope that you have already received a letter from me dated April 5. I am sorry that my earlier letters did not reach the head of the firm.

I have never received a report regarding the tubing returned. However, I have sent in bill for snow samplers to State of California ~~for~~ which your tubing was or rather is being used in order to settle your bill without further delay. Owing to the long time required to ship from Boston to Reno and the return of your first shipment the delay has been extremely long.

To offset your loss on delayed payments, please add interest charges to your bill which we shall be very glad to pay. It will be only fair to do so.

I find 2 more tubes No. 15 - 10 1/2" long that were not shipped back with the stock but it would probably not pay to ship them now.
