the quality of those products, that it is able to turn out in a given length of time. Universities might fittingly be classed capable of making
as their output.
Nevada, as a machine, has to date produced 1165 of those
products, stamped with the guarantee of a Bachelors degree
This number perhaps does not sound very large when compared with Universities such as Stanford and Califormia but to evolve and that the greater part of that evolution has taken
place in fairly recent years. Founded in Elko in 1874, moved to Reno in 1885 to a campus of ten acres and one lone building, Morrill Hall, set out on a
background of sagebrush and sand, the University of Nevada has grown till it today comprises 25 college buildings in a set-
ting of lakes, lawns and shrubs as alluring as to be found at any university in the country.
With property value in the state showing but a slight increase, $\$ 1,000,000$ since the year 1917-1918. The just completed Clark Memorial Library, totaling over $\$ 250,000$ has provided spacious and beautiful quarters for many years to come. The re-
modelled Mackay School of Mines has provided Nevada with a building and equipment amply able to aid her in maintaining the national reputation of her mines department. Nevada,
however, not satisfied with her present facilities, is looking forward into the future when she will have completed her building program with approximately ten further temples of learning.
